Travel Scholarship Details & Application

Description

The Travel Scholarship is a partial tuition award available to Level I and II participants who have no option but to incur exorbitant travel and lodging expenses in order to attend the nearest SPI Training.

Purpose

The Travel Scholarship provides Level I and II participants, who would otherwise be unable to afford the cost of tuition due to travel and lodging expenses, with a more financially viable way to be able to attend the nearest SPI Training if no such Training is scheduled to commence within 100 miles of candidate's residence, within 6 months of submission of scholarship application.

Scholarship Amount

Qualified candidates who complete the Training Application (and are accepted), as well as the scholarship application, are eligible to receive an award equal to 25% of total tuition for a Level I or Level II Training.

Preconditions to Eligibility

Eligible candidates must meet at least one of the following minimum requirements for each scheduled Training module:

- Proven need to incur lodging expenses
- Proven need to incur air travel expenses

Restrictions

- Not applicable if candidate's primary residence is located within 100 miles of a Training scheduled to commence within 6 months of submission of scholarship application.
- Can only be combined with early application discount; cannot be combined with discount incentives or scholarships (candidate may secure an interest-free payment plan)
- Scholarship funds are limited per Training
- SPI reserves the right to determine which candidates are eligible to receive scholarship funds
- If allotted funds are exhausted for any particular Training, no additional funds can be made available
- Scholarship award does not negate the requirement to submit a minimum tuition deposit by the 30 day deadline, nor does it negate any application fees, payment plan fees, nor any other deadlines or restrictions that may apply
- Scholarship application will be reviewed **ONLY** after all requisite documents have been submitted to The Office of Financial Aid. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

***Disclaimer:** Awarding of scholarship does not guarantee acceptance into any particular SPI course, nor does it reserve a seat in said course. Each course has its own registration/application process, which is separate from the application process to secure any discounts or financial aid. Candidates who qualify for the scholarship will only receive award after they are accepted to the course in question.

It is the sole responsibility of candidates to request a scholarship, and all requests must be made to The Office of Financial Aid prior to the scheduled start date indicated for the course on the SPI website. Scholarships cannot be applied retroactively (after the course begins).

How to Apply for the Travel Scholarship

Candidates must complete and submit the Travel Scholarship Application, along with the following documents constituting proof of eligibility, to financialaid@sensorimotor.org for consideration:

- Proof of residence address

- Copy of current photo identification
- Copy of recent utility bill identifying name and physical address

Scholarship applications must be submitted in full no less than 60 days prior to the start of the Training. Late or incomplete applications are subject to rejection.

Scholarship Review Process

The Office of Financial Aid reviews applications to determine eligibility for the Travel scholarship. Please allow up to two weeks after submission of application to receive confirmation of approval or denial.

If candidate's eligibility is approved, the Office of the Bursar will award scholarship amount to candidate's student account only after candidate has successfully applied and been accepted to attend the Training. Candidate may forfeit award if a Training application is not submitted by the indicated deadline on the SPI website.

Obligations

Training participants who are awarded the Travel Scholarship must keep their student financial accounts in good standing by staying up to date on tuition deposits, any associated fees, and payment plans (if applicable). Non-adherence to a payment plan or missed/incomplete payments may result in loss of award and candidate may be assessed additional fees.

Withdrawal

In the event a participant who has received a Travel Scholarship withdraws from the Training in which they have enrolled, participant must submit written notice to Student Services in a timely fashion prior to the next scheduled module. Delays in submitting notice of withdrawal may result in a reduced refund, if any refund might be due (see SPI Refund Policy). Withdrawal from Training will result in a proration of the participant's scholarship award and the SPI Refund Policy will apply.
