

Scholarship FAQs

Why do I need to submit a deposit within 21 days of my scholarship approval?

Scholarship funds are limited and highly competitive. Requiring a deposit ensures that awards go to participants who are ready to commit to their training. This helps us allocate scholarship resources efficiently and reduces the number of unused awards. Deposits are non-refundable.

What happens if I miss the deposit deadline?

If your deposit is not received within 21 days of notification that your scholarship request has been approved, your award may be released and offered to another applicant. Deposits are non-refundable.

If your scholarship offer is released, you may submit a written appeal to have it reinstated for the same training (if funds remain available).

Can I carry my scholarship from Level 1 to Level 2?

If you received a scholarship for Level 1, you may submit a new scholarship request when you are ready to apply to the Level 2 training. Please note that requests are not guaranteed and depend on available funding and eligibility confirmation.

Can I apply for a scholarship before I'm accepted into a training?

No. Scholarship applications are reviewed only after your training application has been approved.

Can I combine my scholarship with other discounts?

No. Scholarships cannot be combined with one another, nor with other discounts.

Can I transfer my scholarship to another training or person?

No. Scholarships are non-transferable and may not be applied to another training or participant.

What happens if I withdraw from my training?

Scholarship awards are applied directly to tuition and are not redeemable for cash or refundable. If you withdraw or are dismissed, the award's value will be prorated and excluded from any refund calculation. Training application fees and deposits are non-refundable.

Before accepting a scholarship, please review SPI's full withdrawal, refund, and cancellation policies.

What is the typical review timeline?

Most scholarship applications are reviewed within two weeks after your training application has been received and approved. You'll receive an email notification once a decision has been made regarding your scholarship request.

Important Notes

- Scholarships are limited and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Scholarships cannot be combined with one another nor combined with discounts.
- Scholarships cannot be applied retroactively and must be awarded before training begins.
- A training deposit is required within 21 days of notification of your scholarship approval. Deposits are non-refundable.
- Scholarships are non-transferable and cannot be applied to other trainings.
